It is now sponsoring the "Never Again" Hiroshima Exhibit at Concordia University. This exhibit from the Hiroshima Ground Zero Museum in Japan commemorates the 70th anniversary since the bombing of Hiroshima. The opening of the exhibit will take place on August 6th from 11 am- 2 pm. The event will begin with prayers for peace followed by a luncheon with a keynote speech by atomic bomb survivor Mr. Ed Kawasaki. The event will be at Concordian's George R.
