# **News from Your Search Committee**

The Pastoral Search Committee was voted in and commissioned at our Congregational Meeting on January 31<sup>st</sup>. The members of the Committee are: Carole Greenauer, Karen Kulm, Kimberly Lewis, Gina Marquardt, Janet Melton, Laurie Parafinczuk, Tom Renner, Jeff Schnabel, and Dave Slocum. We had our first meeting last week with our Conference Minister, Dr. Walter John Boris. We received instructions on how to proceed. Search Committee members engage in a 4-Way Covenant – a Covenant with our prospective pastor, the congregation, the Conference and the Holy Spirit.

The next steps will be to complete a Congregational Profile. The whole congregation will be invited to participate in this process of describing the hopes and challenges of our church. We will do this through congregational activities, surveys and conversations.

All Search Committee members have made a commitment to confidentially. <u>Members must not</u> <u>share the names of individuals under</u> <u>consideration</u>. Even to speak in generalities about location or experience or gender can risk folks guessing at whom candidates are and this could jeopardize candidate's current jobs. The Committee *will*, however, always keep you posted about where we are in the process.

How long will all of this take? Our Conference Minister said, "The relationship between pastor and congregations is a trust covenant, like a marriage. You are not looking for someone to fill a job; you are searching for a partner in ministry." We look forward to working with you in this process!
