### Congregation will Vote on Mortgage Plan Changes This Sunday

In 2009, we undertook an ambitious plan of maintenance of our church building, which involved taking out a mortgage, to be paid by engaging in 4 capital campaigns spread over 12 years. We are currently more than two-thirds of the way through the fulfillment period for the third capital campaign.

In 2012, we adopted a plan to efficiently pay off the mortgage. The 2012 plan calls for us to undertake a fourth capital campaign next spring. However, a proposal to change that plan was approved by the Property & Finance Committee and by the Council in October. It will be presented to the congregation for adoption at the Congregational Meeting on November 12th.

In a nutshell, the proposed change to the 2012 plan will:

- · eliminate the need for the fourth Capital Campaign in 2018
- call for a year-end drive to secure \$36,000 in contributions from the congregation for principal reduction while using \$36,000 in matching funds from the "Surplus from Operations" fund
- changes the mortgage end-game from rapid & efficient payoff (using funds from a 4th campaign) to a 30-year mortgage using \$18,000/year from the operating budget to make mortgage payments.


As we prepare to move back into our building, this is the right time to make this change. In February we must renegotiate our loan from the Cornerstone Fund. The 2012 plan has brought us to the point where the Operating Budget in 2018 will be able to cover a \$1,500 per month mortgage payment. We are very close to being able to reduce the outstanding balance on the loan to a level where our refinanced loan payment can be reduced to \$1,500 per month or less.

The plan we adopted in 2012 has achieved remarkable efficiency from the dollars contributed toward the mortgage! To put in perspective what we have achieved so far, to date we have paid off more than 50% of the original \$776,000 balance of the first mortgage. We have made payments totaling \$586,690; \$388,090 was applied to principal (66%) and \$198,600 was paid in interest (34%). The outstanding balance on 10/13/17 was \$360,796.

## Building Update Progress Report 11/8/17 Good News this week, we have building permit in our possession!.

- The fire sprinkler underground line is installed, inspected and back-filled. I'll keep you posted on landscaping.
- The scaffolding in the Sanctuary was started last Friday and will be green tagged for use Friday 11/10/17.
- Demo and framing on the existing skylight on the east end will begin next week 11/13/17.
- Insulation is expected to start on the ceilings in the classroom areas on Monday 11/13/17.
