CONSTRUCTION UPDATE FOR WEEK MARCH 4TH

A flurry of activity this week in all parts of the building.

- Framing has passed inspection in the Sanctuary.
- HVAC has started in Bradford Hall and the kitchen HVAC has been complete
- Framing on the windows is complete for the windows on the east side.
- Insulation has started in the sanctuary. It is anticipated that the insulation inspection on walls only to take place Monday 3/12/18. The delay of the insulation was due to the sound low voltage wiring being installed and Inspected.
- Saw cutting for the rough plumbing in the new kitchen has been done and rough plumbing has started. This phase will be inspected after submitted drawing come back from the county.
- Low voltage wiring inspection is taking place tomorrow 3/8/18.
- Insulation on the Sanctuary ceiling will start Monday 3/12/18.
- Drywall will be started in the Sanctuary only on Monday 3/12/18.
- The class room area framing cannot be inspected until the submitted drawings come back from the county.

The Re-Imaging Committee did not meet this week but will meet next week.
