Construction Update Week of April 2 A Lot of Progress Made This Week!

- The drywall is complete in the Sanctuary, screw inspection has passed inspection and drywall finish has begun.
- Framing inspection has passed and drywall has started in the class room areas upper and lower levels.
- New gutters have been installed and painting is To Be Determined, weather permitting.
- The New Entry Deck has started with the steel inspection passing inspection and the piers have been poured. This concrete must cure for 7 days before building a structure on any piers.
- The last of the insulation inspection passed.
- The HVAC inspection has been called in for Thursday. This will conclude rough HVAC inspections.

The underground plumbing is called in for Thursday and this will conclude all rough plumbing inspections.

Because the county delayed its response on change orders submitted, it will be necessary to set up a tent for Randy Franklin and Brian Fick's wedding on May 19th and Jennifer's installation on May 20th. Off-site parking may need to be considered, including car-pooling where possible. Additional light towers will be set up, courtesy of Ed Laskaris, from Belfor.

The Re-Imaging Committee met to make final selection of carpet and ordering will take place this week. A very busy week!
